### ALPINE's success continues in Poland

- **Construction of a public sports/swimming/spa complex in Nowy Targ**
- **Building contract worth approx. 5.5 million euros**

The consortium comprised of ALPINE Construction Polska sp.zo.o, ALPINE Bau Deutschland AG and P.H.U. Potoczak is building a sports and spa facility in Nowy Targ, just 65 kilometers south of Krakow. It will be the district's first public sports/swimming/spa complex and is designed to improve the region's infrastructure. The building contract worth 5.5 million euros was recently signed by the city's Mayor, Dipl. Ing. Marek Fryźlewicz. The pool project originates from the eM4 studio in Krakow and from the Superjednostka architecture and building projects in Jawor. "Poland is a very interesting and important market for us. Apart from our large-scale projects such as the construction of stadiums and the ongoing infrastructure projects, we are continuing to develop our permanent business in Poland," says Karsten Hell, Chairman of the Board at ALPINE Bau Deutschland AG and the Management of ALPINE Bau GmbH. "This project will allow us to develop the local infrastructure significantly," adds Juliusz Sikora, authorized representative of ALPINE Construction Polska sp.zo.o.

#### The project

The construction site has an area of more than 2,300 square meters; the complex itself will measure approx. 29,000 m<sup>2</sup>. It will have a sports pool with six lanes (meeting the FINA Regulations), a learners' pool and a wading/children's pool. Future visitors will also find a Finnish sauna, a steam room, a brine grotto, hydromassage tubs as well as a fitness studio and climbing wall.

#### ALPINE strong in Poland

ALPINE is currently building the National Stadium in Warsaw, Poland for the EURO 2012, boasting 55,000 spectator seats, as well as the PGE Arena in Danzig for approx. 44,000 spectators. ALPINE won the contract to build the University of Danzig's Department of Chemistry in July 2010. The stadiums in Posen and Krakow were already completed in the fall of 2010.
