### **ALPINE: Best bidder for National Stadium in Warsaw Offer to build stadium with 55,000 seats for 295 million euros. Construction to take 24 months.**

After winning the contract to build the stadiums for the 2012 European Championships in Danzig and Posen a few days ago, the joint venture featuring ALPINE was the best bidder for the National Stadium in Warsaw. "We are extremely pleased with these results and proud that our commitment in Poland is taking such a positive turn," says Dr. Peter Preindl, ALPINE's managing director.

Again the tender was submitted by a joint venture comprised of ALPINE Bau GmbH, ALPINE Bau Deutschland AG, ALPINE Construction Polska and Hydrobudowa Polska. S.A., ALPINE being responsible for the lead management.

Designed by the internationally-active architects J.S.K., the National Stadium will have 55,000 seats. The contract value is approx. 295 million euros (1,263 million Polish zlotky). An impressive steel-cable truss construction was chosen for the roof, giving the stadium a particularly stunning appearance. Construction is expected to take 24 months.

#### **Competence in stadium construction**

ALPINE has extensive experience in executing large-scale stadium projects, gaining highest competence on an international scale in the construction of sports facilities.

Following the construction of the Allianz Arena in Munich, ALPINE recently completed the Dubai Cricket Stadium in the world's biggest sports center. ALPINE is responsible for the construction of the Wörthersee Stadium, the Tivoli Stadium and the enlargement of the Salzburg stadium in Wals-Siezenheim for the EURO 2008.
